PREVENTION AND PROHIBITION OF RAGGING IN NIE INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, MYSURU

Ragging is strictly banned in NIE Institute of Technology. If anybody found indulged in such kind of activities, strict action will be taken irrespective of the extent as per the regulations prevailing of the State and the Central Government. As per the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP No. **24295 of 2006 dated 16-05-2007 and in Civil Appeal number 887 of 2009, dated 08-05-2009**, as per All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) notification numbered **F.No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009** and directives issued by Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi, NIE Institute of Technology has constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee. As per the directions of AICTE the committee comprises: Head of the institution, representatives of civil and police administration, local media, NGOs involved in youth activities, representatives of dedicated faculty members of various departments, representatives of fresher's parents, representatives of students belonging to the fresher's category as well as senior students, committed non-teaching staff members of various departments with a diverse mix of membership in terms of level as well as gender. It shall monitor the anti-ragging activities in the campus. The anti-ragging committee members will pay frequent visits, conduct periodic meetings/counseling with students. The anti-ragging committee shall recommend and decide suitable punishments to those found guilty.

SAY NO TO RAGGING

Following acts shall amount to ragging

- a. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
- b. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
- c. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
- d. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;

- e. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
- g. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- i. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-

- (i) Cancellation of admission
- (ii) Suspension from attending classes
- (iii) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- (iv) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- (v) Withholding results
- (vi) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- (vii) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- (viii) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- (ix) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- (x) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
